The Love Project: Doing Good In Our Community!

Since our newsletter goes out to many of the homes and businesses in the area we thought it would be a good idea to provide space to let people know about the needs of those programs which help disadvantaged children.



The Love Project is a food pantry located in Veneta which has operated for over 25 years under the umbrella of the Mid Lane Cares. The pantry allows families and individuals the chance to get free, supplemental groceries on a monthly basis. They work with Fern Ridge Gleaners, local farms, the Farmer's Market and Food for Lane County.

Together these groups help provide 100,000 lbs of food each year through the Love Project. Twice a month members of the Love Project assemble at the community center and break down donations for their families and for the "adoptees", people who are physically unable to glean but are in need.

Volunteers are needed and greatly appreciated for this wonderful outreach to our community!

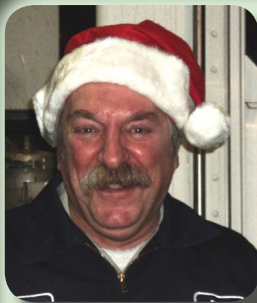

CLEAN and UNBROKEN
glass jars and bottles only in the blue box



Yard Debris

"If it GROWS it GOES"

Place in your grey yard debris cart anything that grows above the ground in your yard.

Grass, leaves, branches up to 4" in diameter, brush, fruit tree discards and plant vegetation.

- Close the lid
- 120 pound limit
- No dirt or rocks
- No bags
- No Pet Waste
- No Poison Oak

COMMINGLE RECYCLE INSTRUCTIONS:

All Recycling Must Be CLEAN!

INCLUDE ONLY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Cardboard--must be flat
- Paper--mail, newspaper, magazines, phone books, paper bags, wrapping paper, computer paper, colored paper
- SHREDDED PAPER must be contained in a paper bag with the top rolled closed
- Plastic--jugs, tubs & bottles only--NO LIDS
- Metal--food and beverage cans (NO UNATTACHED LIDS) & clean aluminum foil crumpled into a ball no smaller than a fist
- ASEPTIC TetraPak® cartons--gable top milk and juice cartons 1/2 gallon and larger
