Now that the holidays are over, you might be wondering what to do with all of the leftover holiday packaging. Here is a list of common holiday items and where they should go;

Blue Recycling Cart: Paper wrapping paper, flattened cardboard boxes, metal food and beverage containers, plastic jugs, tubs, bottles, news papers, greeting cards, receipts and paper gift bags. (All recycling must be clean and free of lids)

Green Trash Cart: Tissue paper, bows, ribbons, plastic ornament containers, broken ornaments, metallic or cellophane wrapping paper, Styrofoam, plastic gifts bags, broken toys, plastic clamshell food containers, metal cookie tins, candy wrappers, garlands and broken Christmas lights.

(Please bag all trash. Remember to Stop at the Top!)

Grey Yard Debris Cart: poinsettia plants, holiday flower bouquet's, mistletoe and live wreaths.

(Any non vegetation décor should be put in the green trash cart)

Blue Box for Glass Recycling: glass food and beverage bottles only please. (No lids, bags or boxes.)

Not sure what to do about the Christmas tree? We encourage you to look in the newspaper for a listing of local groups picking up trees for fundraisers.

Still have something that you aren't sure where it should go and you don't have time to call? Go to Sanipac.com and check out the Waste Wizard. Simply type in the name of the item you want to dispose of, and it will give you options on where to properly dispose of it.

Include ONLY the following items:

- Flat Cardboard
- Paper mail, newspaper, magazines, phone books, paper bags, wrapping paper or computer paper
- Shredded Paper enclosed in a paper bag
- Plastic jugs, tubs or bottles NO lids
- Metal food and beverage containers, NO unattached lids. Aluminum foil
 must be clean and in a ball no smaller than your fist.
