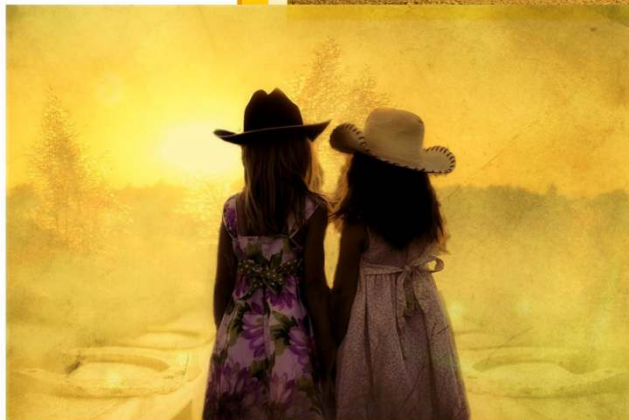
While we are still going to build some bikes, we have shifted our focus to helping grant wishes through the [Make-A-Wish®](#) foundation.
