Garbage collection is a dangerous job. Drivers operate a 25 foot long truck weighing in empty at 30,000 pounds. Each driver services hundreds of stops per day in varying locations, all while obeying traffic laws, watching out for fellow motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists and animals. Don't forget one of the most important parts of the day, waving to the children eagerly waiting in their front windows for the garbage man to arrive.

Lytix, formally known as Drive Cam, is a safety tool that helps identify why accidents happen using a video recorder mounted to the front and back of the truck to capture and assist in correcting risky driving habits. All of the trucks at Sanipac are equipped with this tool.
