



Although it is still winter, you may be thinking about pruning trees and shrubs, or maybe even trimming up the yard a little. We thought that this may be a great time to refresh you on the types of material to put in your yard debris cart.

At Sanipac, we have a motto for what goes in the yard debris cart: **"If it grows, it goes!"** Following this motto answers the majority of questions around the dos and don'ts of yard debris recycling.

Your yard debris cart is for anything that grows above the ground, but please no dirt, rocks, pet waste, plastic bags or poison oak. The most frequent types of items placed in the cart are - plants, grass clippings, leaves, branches up to 4" in diameter, garden and fruit tree discards, bushes and flowers.

We are also happy to take seasonal items including; pumpkins, gourds, ears of corn and pine cones. Christmas trees and wreaths are welcome in the cart, as long as they are disassembled – no wire, flocking, decorations or ornaments.

If you have questions about an item, please call or email us, we are more than happy to help you!

Another great thing about the yard debris cart, you don't have to bag anything that goes in it! Simply put the yard waste in the cart and close the lid all the way for pickup.

If you plan on putting your yard debris cart out in early spring, please store it in a warm place the day before your pickup, so the contents do not freeze and remain in the cart on your pickup day. If the contents do freeze, please use a shovel to loosen the items so the cart is completely emptied on your pickup day.

In the City limits of Veneta, yard debris will be picked up weekly during the months of April, May and November.

# YARD DEBRIS RECYCLING

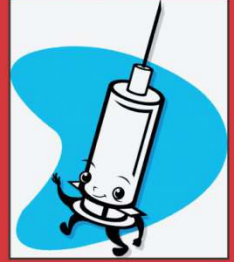
## IF IT GROWS IT GOES

Place in your grey yard debris cart anything that grows above the ground in your yard.

Grass, leaves, branches up to 4" in diameter, brush, fruit tree discards and plant vegetation

- Close the lid
- 120 pound limit
- **No** dirt or rocks
- **No** bags
- **No** pet waste
- **No** poison oak

Sharps **NEVER** belong in your recycling or garbage carts!

## COMMINGLE RECYCLE INSTRUCTIONS:

All Recycling Must Be **CLEAN!**

INCLUDE ONLY THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- **Flat Cardboard**
- **Paper** - mail, newspaper, magazines, phone books, paper bags, wrapping paper, computer paper, colored paper
- **SHREDDED PAPER** - must be contained in a paper bag with the top rolled closed
- **Plastic** - jugs, tubs & bottles only - **NO LIDS**
- **Metal** - food and beverage cans (NO UNATTACHED LIDS) & clean aluminum foil crumpled into a ball no smaller than a fist



## Haul-i-days

If your pick up day falls on or following one of these holidays, your pick up will be one day later ending with Friday's pick up being done on Saturday.

**New Years Day**  
**Memorial Day**  
**4th July**  
**Labor Day**  
**Thanksgiving Day**  
**Christmas Day**
